Vending machines are available. You will want to bring money for two special offerings—they are for A) Our Guatemala Partnership, and B) Youth Ministries.

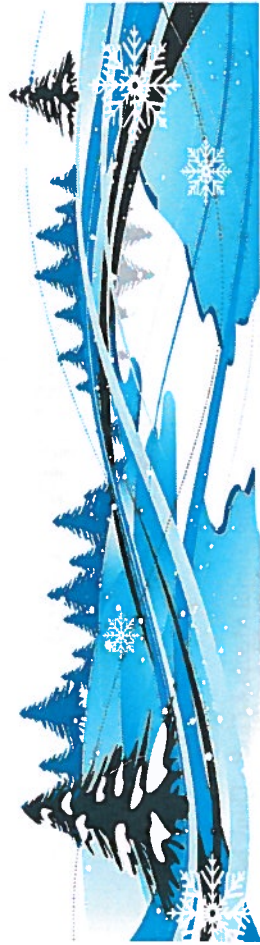
### CONTACT INFORMATION
