## Preliminary Packing List

## What to Expect at our Camps

**HOUSING** Walter Scott offers a mix of indoor housing options and outdoor sleeping structures. Lodging assignments will be made once registration is complete and you will be notified prior to the beginning of camp. Typically, everyone at any one camp will have similar sleeping arrangements. Directors, in consultation with the Resident Minister and Caretaker, will make the final decision. Please, let us know as soon as possible if there are any circumstances that would require a specific sleeping or lodging arrangement for your camper(s) and we will do our best to accommodate accordingly.

**MEDICATION** Remember, medication (prescription or over-the-counter) must be reported to the director during check-in. A nurse or designated staff will administer medication according to prescription and directions. All medications must be brought in original packaging with name and directions. Any other drugs, illegal or recreational, are not allowed at Walter Scott.

**SMOKE FREE** Youth camps at Walter Scott are smoke-free environments. Tobacco and related products, including but not limited to cigarettes, cigars, smokeless tobacco, e-cigs, or vape pens, are not allowed in the campgrounds.

**TECHNOLOGY** Technology provides opportunities for communication, education, and engagement. Cellphones and other personal communication devices are generally allowed at camp; however, directors and counselors might restrict their use during the camping program. All campers are asked to adhere to the regulations established by staff.

**HARMFUL ITEMS** Weapons of any kind, fireworks, and any other items that are likely to harm any guests, wildlife, or the campgrounds are not allowed.

**MAIL** Letters and care packages are distributed during the week. We encourage parents/guardians and churches to consider sending mail to their camper(s).
